"**RESOLVED THAT** Ms. Jaini Jain (DIN 07859496), an existing Independent Director of the Company, who holds office up to February 20, 2023, was appointed as an Additional Director (Non-Executive, Independent) of the Company, with effect to February 20, 2023, by the Board of Directors, based on the recommendation of the Nomination and Remuneration Committee in terms of Section 161 of the Companies Act, 2013 ("Act") read with Article 73 of the Articles of Association of the Company, who is eligible for appointment and who has consented to act as a Director of the Company."

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

Pursuant to Sections 102 and 110 of the Companies Act, 2013 ("Act")

The following statement sets out all material facts relating to the resolution to be passed as mentioned in the accompanying Notice. Ms. Jaini Jain (DIN-07859496) was appointed as a Non-Executive Independent Director of the Company, for a period of 5 (five) years, with effect from February 20, 2018 to February 20, 2023, in terms of the provisions of Section 149 of the Act and Regulation 25 of Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015 (**"SEBI Listing Regulations"**). Accordingly, the first term of five years of Ms. Jaini Jain, as a Non-Executive Independent Director of the Company, expired on February 20, 2023.

Based on the skills, competence and expertise in understanding, of global business dynamics, appreciation of long-term trends, strategic choices and experience in guiding and leading management teams, developing governance practices, contribution in the Board and Committee meetings, performance evaluation, the Board, on the recommendation of the Nomination and Remuneration Committee, has determined that the re-appointment of Ms. Jaini Jain would be beneficial to the Company.

On recommendation of the Board of Directors and Nomination and Remuneration Committee, Ms. Jaini Jain (DIN- DIN-07859496 is re-appointment as a Non-Executive Independent Director for a second consecutive term from February 20, 2023 up to February 19, 2028, not liable to retire by rotation, subject to the approval of the Members by way of a Special Resolution.

The Company has received a declaration from her to the effect that she meets the criteria of independence as provided in Section 149(6) of the Act and Rules framed thereunder and Regulation 16(1)(b) of the SEBI Listing Regulations. In terms of Regulation 25(8) of SEBI Listing Regulations, she has confirmed that she is not aware of any circumstance or situation which exists or may be reasonably anticipated that could impair or impact her ability to discharge her duties. She has also confirmed that she is in compliance with Rules 6(1) and 6(2) of the Companies (Appointment and Qualification of Directors) Rules, 2014, with respect to the registration with the data bank of Independent Directors maintained by the Indian Institute of Corporate Affairs.

Ms. Jaini Jain has also confirmed that she is not disqualified from being appointed as Director, in terms of the provisions of Section 164 (2) of the Act and is not debarred to hold the office of a Director by virtue of any order passed by SEBI or any other authority and has given her consent to act as a Director of the Company. There is no inter se relationship between her and any other member of the Board and other Key Managerial Personnel.



In the opinion of the Board, Ms. Jaini Jain is a person of integrity, fulfils the conditions specified in the Act and the Rules made thereunder read with the provisions of the Listing Regulations, each as amended, and is independent of the management of the Company.

The terms and conditions of re-appointment of Ms. Jaini Jain are available for inspection by the Members at the Registered Office of the Company during business hours on all working days, until the last date of remote e-voting.
